Tech Prep Registration Is Open-

EHS Students enrolled in Tech Prep can earn college credit in high school courses that are formally aligned - articulated - with college courses. Most of the Tech Prep high school classes are part of a Career and Technical Education (CTE) program and they connect with a professional/technical certificate or degree. To earn college credit students must follow a few simple steps: Register with Tech Prep CC while taking the class-www.techprepcc.org, pay the non-refundable \$46 annual consortium fee by JUNE 15TH - <http://pay.techprepcc.org>, and receive a grade of "B" (3.0) or higher in the class. 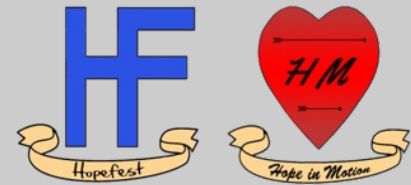
Eastlake Baseball Fundraiser - March 11th
