Principal Message

Dear Wolves,

As students start the registration process for classes next year, we wanted to spend some time explaining many of the options at Eastlake. With the onset of Core 24, students in the Class of 2019 and beyond now need 2.0 credits of Visual or Performing Arts. Students can fulfill this requirement in many ways, including through Art, Music and Drama.

Over the last couple of years, we have dramatically increased our Art offerings to include both 3D and Digital Art. Next year we have added Advanced and AP 3D Art, as well as Advanced and AP Photography.

The numbers in our Music program have also grown exponentially. Our Band program continues to thrive and last year we added Chamber Orchestra, an advanced strings course. This year we have added an advanced level Choir class called Chamber Choir.

We have also continued to develop a dynamic Drama program, adding Writing for Stage and Screen to Drama 1 and Drama 2.

These Fine Arts classes enrich our school culture, and teach our students valuable skills such as curiosity, creativity, initiative and perseverance.

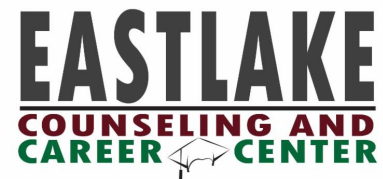
