### Talent Show February 8th:

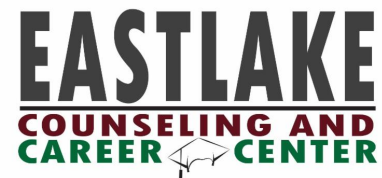
