Principal Message

Dear Wolves,

Earlier this week we had tragedy at Eastlake High School. This is a sad time for Eastlake, and in these tragic situations we try to remain very conscientious and supportive to all involved, both during the crisis and in its aftermath.

On the day it occurred, we worked closely with Eastside Fire and Rescue, the Sammamish Police Department and the Lake Washington School District, following very clearly established processes and protocols for these types of situations. Later that afternoon, teachers announced this situation to students and informed them that our Counselors are available as well as teachers and other staff to serve as resources for our Eastlake students, staff and families as they go through the grieving process or have the need to talk or express difficult feelings. Our Counselors have remained available for students all week, and will continue to be a resource in the coming weeks. We then sent an announcement to families about the situation and also informed them that our Counselors are available to support their students. We also included some common signs of distress and a recommendation of how parents can help by simply talking and listening to their kids.

Next week, students will have another opportunity to express their thoughts and feelings in Homeroom and then we will provide them with a chance to write a note to the family.

Thank you for all you do to support Eastlake High School and let us know how we can help your student.

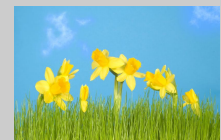
