AP Testing Registration

AP testing will be from May 1st to May 19th. The registration period is from March 6 to March 17 and students should have received a registration packet in their AP class. Extras are in the Counseling Center. Please complete the following steps and submit the registration envelope to the bookkeeper no later than Friday, March 17th at the end of last lunch.

- Fill out the registration envelope with the required information.
- Pay online at [lwsd.org using Parent Access](https://lwsd.org/parent-access) OR pay by check or cash. If you pay online, print the receipt and enclose it in the registration envelope. If you pay by check, make the check out to LWSD and write the student's name on the check and enclose the check in the registration envelope.
- Return the registration envelope with the online payment receipt, check

or cash enclosed (\$96 per exam) to the bookkeeper at your high school.

- Please see Mrs. Harrison in the Counseling Center with any questions.

A Note From The Bookkeeper about AP Registration

Turn in your AP Registration early! There will be long lines next week, and if students wait until Thursday or Friday to turn in their payment and envelopes- they run the risk of not getting registered before the Friday 1 PM deadline. Please, pay online and just have your student drop off the receipt and envelope to the Bookkeeper. This will save them time, and make sure they are registered before the cut-off.
