Short Version (SV):

- Leave me a message at (425)936-1539 PLEASE SPELL LAST NAME
- Send in a note
- Call me at (425) 936-1500 x53524

Long Version (LV):

- Our answering service is available 24/7. Please call (425)936-1539 and tell me the student's name, spell the last name, date of absence, and reason. This is also a good place to let us know that your child will be LATE to school.
- Please feel free to stop by my Attendance window anytime to discuss your child's attendance.
- For EARLY RELEASE / DAY OF absences, the best thing to do is send in a note from you with your child to the office in the morning. We will get a pass written for them to leave Eastlake early. Teachers are instructed not to let students leave their classroom without a note. If your child has left their note on the counter at home next to the breakfast dishes, you can call me at (425) 936-1500 and ask for Haven and I will get a pass to them for early dismissal.

Freshman, sophomore, and junior award recipients: A certificate of award that can be used in their college portfolio. Students may also reapply as seniors for the financial award.

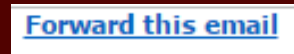
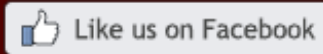
Senior Send Off Sign Up Alert!
