Principal Message

Dear Wolves,

The election results have consumed a lot of conversations this week, and our teachers have done an amazing job guiding students through this tense time. With a constant focus on learning, we actually encourage civil discourse, where students respectfully talk and empathetically listen to one another.

I have attached the Lake Washington School District guidelines for <u>teaching about elections</u>. Our Civility Policy (Policy ACAA) does allow for the expression of controversial or differing viewpoints that may be offensive to some persons. However, such expression requires that:

- 1) The ideas are presented in a respectful manner and at a time and place that are appropriate.
- 2) There is not a material disruption, or a reasonably anticipated disruption, to the educational process.

Examples of uncivil or disrespectful behavior include directing vulgar, obscene or profane gestures or words at another individual; taunting, jeering, inciting others to taunt or jeer at an individual; interrupting another individual repeatedly; raising one's voice in anger at another person; or using derogatory epithets. Educators must always respond immediately when uncivil behaviors are expressed in the classroom or school.

We all share the same goal of maintaining our civil society.


