Dear Wolves,

As the end of First Quarter approaches on November 8th there is more attention than ever on student grades. Students recently completed an academic goal setting document in Homeroom where they identified an academic area of need and planned out deliberate steps they will take to reach that goal. Students have also been able to assign themselves to a teacher in Wolf Time on Thursday (9:15-9:50) that will directly help them reach the goal they've identified.

Another support for students and families are the teacher's PowerSchool Learning, previously known as Haiku, websites you can use to find class materials and resources as well as see a calendar of upcoming assignments, tests, and projects. All teachers maintain an electronic gradebook through Skyward. Both PowerSchool Learning and Skyward can be accessed through this [Parent Portal](#) link. Teachers are expected to update the electronic gradebook in Skyward every two weeks, with exceptions being made for major projects and papers. We have set some dates for this two-week rolling window for the rest of the first semester:

- October 31st by 7:30am
- November 14th by 7:30am
- November 28th by 7:30am
- December 12th by 7:30am
- January 9th by 7:30am
- January 23rd by 7:30am

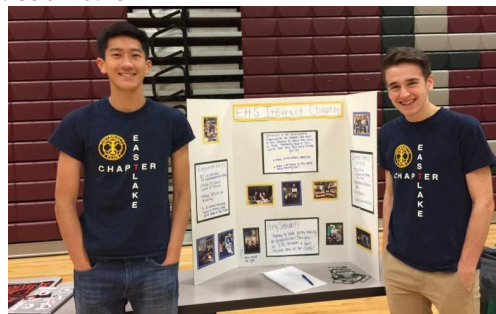
