Central Washington University will open its doors for the fall 2017 school year

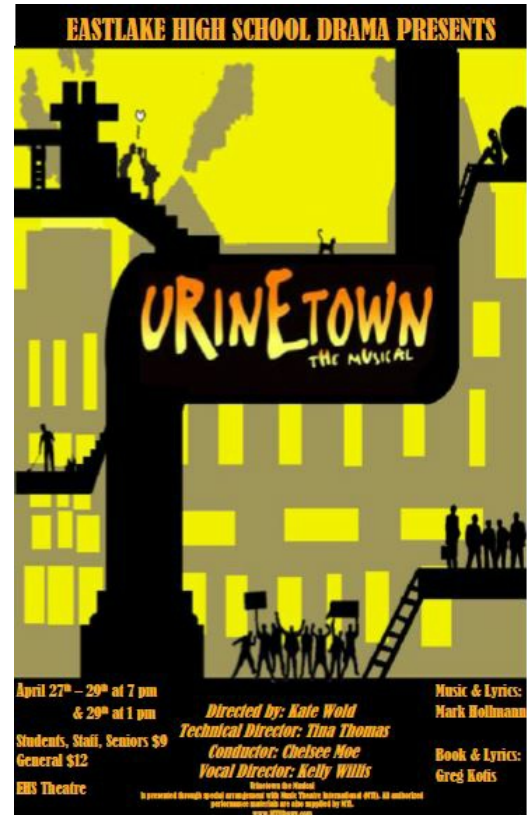

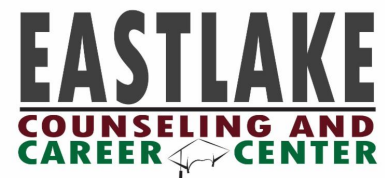

Washington Network for Innovative Careers (WANIC) offers courses at various high schools in local districts. These programs are open to students entering grades 9 through 12 in Bellevue, Everett, Issaquah, Lake Washington, Northshore, Riverview and Snoqualmie Valley School Districts. Tuition is free; the only cost to attend a WANIC Summer Skills Academy class is the \$50 supply fee (assistance available for students who qualify for free or reduced lunch). Students earn .5 Occupational Education high school credits except where noted differently in the description([available on the website](#)). Students provide their own transportation and lunch. After you receive your confirmation of enrollment, the class fee is due by June 1st to hold your spot. ## Facts About Alcohol and other Drugs -

**FACT:** Alcohol and other drugs are the leading causes of crime among youth.

**FACT:** Alcohol and other drugs are the leading factors in teenage suicide.

**FACT:** More than 23 million people over the age of 12 are addicted to alcohol and other drugs, affecting millions more people - spouses, children, family members, friends, neighbors and colleagues at work.

**FACT:** Marijuana and Grades: 19.3% of students ages 12-17 who receive average grades of "D" or lower used marijuana in the past month and 6.9% of students with grades of "C" or above used marijuana in the past month.

**FACT:** Not everyone is using drugs.

One reason some teens decide to start smoking marijuana, drinking alcohol or using other drugs is because they think "everyone is doing it." And, since they think that the majority of their peers are using drugs, they draw the conclusion that it must be OK. If most of the people that you are hanging out with are drinking alcohol or using drugs, it's easy to think that "everyone is doing it." But statistics don't back up that claim.
