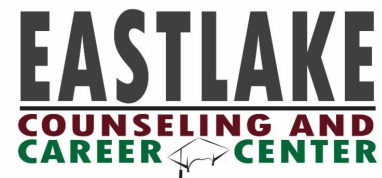

The purpose of the NROTC Program is to educate and train qualified young men and women for service as commissioned officers in the Navy's unrestricted line, the Navy Nurse Corps and the Marine Corps. Selected applicants for the NROTC Scholarship Program are awarded scholarships through a highly competitive national selection process, and receive full tuition, books stipend, educational fees and other financial benefits at many of the country's leading colleges and universities. Upon graduation, midshipmen are commissioned as officers in the unrestricted line Naval Reserve or Marine Corps Reserve.

Fourteen students from EHS attended the International DECA Competition (ICDC) in Anaheim, CA April 25-30th. Those students included seniors Colin James, Jennifer Linnenkamp, Gurveen Rekhi, Kira Spiro, Sofia Viotto, and Isabella Viotto; juniors Nate Wilson, Rachel Clark, Jessie Gates, Devin Patel, Divya Parimi and Braden Loveall; sophomores, Sanjana Sridhar and Preju Kanuparth. Nine of the fourteen students competed in individual or team events.

Three of those students, Isabella Viotto, Sofia Viotto, and Braden Loveall placed in the top twenty percent of their event, qualifying them for finals. In the final round, Braden Loveall and Sofia Viotto placed in the Top 10 internationally. Braden Loveall competed in Principles of Hospitality and Tourism and Sofia Viotto competed in Food and Restaurant
