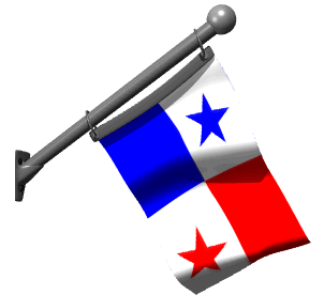
Homecoming Dance - To the Moon and Back

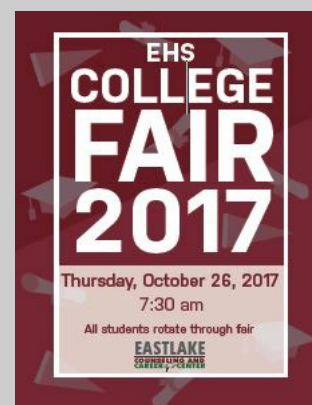

- The head should be approximately 1/2 the total width of the photo.
- Avoid accessories such as cars, animals, weapons, musical instruments.
- Students should be appropriately dressed to meet the school dress code.
- Digital images should be at least 300 dpi and in a .jpg, .tiff or eps format - Word, excel, publisher or other formats will not be accepted.
- Be sure to complete ALL requested fields so the image is assigned to the correct student.

You should be taken directly to a spot to upload the photo. If the systems asks for a Username, enter in the series of numbers at the end of the link (408913603).
