Principal Message

Dear Wolves,

As the end of First Quarter approaches on November 7th, students become more consumed and concerned about grades. Please remind your students of all the ways in which they can receive support from their teachers. Our teachers are available before and after school for Office Hours. Students can also sign up to get help from a teacher during Wolf Time on Tuesdays and Thursday.

Another support for students and families are the PowerSchool Learning websites. On these websites, you can find class materials and resources as well as see a calendar of upcoming assignments, tests, and projects. All teachers maintain an electronic gradebook through Skyward. Both PowerSchool Learning and Skyward can be accessed through the Parent Portal.

Teachers are expected to update their electronic gradebook in Skyward every two weeks, with exceptions being made for major projects and papers. This year, we will have our grading requirement deadlines coincide with the athletic grade check dates, approximately one time per month, with the expectation that teachers are also updating their grade books mid-month. The dates for updating grade books this year are: November 1, December 1, January 2, February 1, March 2, April 9, May 1.

An additional communication tool that we will be piloting first quarter is to send parents an email if their student has below a 70% in any class. The email will be meant to encourage conversation in the family about work hard to bring the grade up prior to the end of 1st semester.

Our Eastlake Attendance secretary has put together a few scenarios to guide parents through attendance questions. See this weeks scenario below.

Question - My child will be late to school because they _____ (don't feel good, overslept, have an appointment, etc.). What do I need to do to excuse this tardy?

Attendance

Answer - Have your child bring in a dated and signed note by you with the reason for the tardy.

OR

Leave me a message at (425) 936-1539 with the reason for the tardy and the estimated time of your child's arrival.

Did you know...? If you have a DOCTOR'S NOTE that covers your child's absence, that absence will not affect your child's Semester Total absences. If there has been an absence where a doctor was not seen such as the common cold, headaches, etc, that absence can still be excused, but it will be included in the Semester Total count.

- Be sure to complete ALL requested fields so the image is assigned to the correct student.
