ASB CARD

- ASB cards are \$60. Replacement fee is \$5.

- All students are required to have a picture ID taken at no cost. This should be done at orientation.


SCHEDULES & GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

- Choose Humanities block (3 choices)
- Choose Math – write in level

SENIOR CLASSES

- Choose English
- Choose Math or elective
- Choose Science or elective
- Must equal 7 credits

GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

24 credits total
