Helpful tips with credit checks

- 1 semester = .5 credits
- Have students cross off classes completed and circle seven .5 credits, for classes that they're currently enrolled in.
- Once a student completes all the credits in a particular subject (ex. science), have them mark any additional credits under elective credit at the bottom.

MATH

- Students must earn 1.0 credit in algebra 1, 1.0 credit in geometry, and 1.0 credit in algebra 2 for graduation requirements (3.0 credits in high school)

STATE REQUIREMENTS

- WA State History: Students meet the requirement for WA state history in their 8th grade SS class. If you look at the bottom of the transcript it'll say whether or not they met it. If it is not met they will need to talk to their counselor about making it up.
- On the bottom of the transcript it will also tell them if they have met State Testing Requirements. The High School and Beyond won't be marked "met" until 2nd semester senior year.

FOREIGN LANGUAGE

- All students MUST have 2.0 credits of the same language for 2 years/levels. It cannot be Spanish 1 and ASL 1. It can't be the same language repeated (ex. Spanish 1 this year and again next year).

Additional Notes

- Point out the College Admissions Requirement chart on page 7 of Course Catalog as well as the 4-year planner on page 9
- Students should register for 7.0 credits AND 3.0 ALTERNATES
- Running Start and WaNIC students must register for 7.0 EHS classes at the time of registration and place an * next to courses they would like removed if admitted to the program
- No more than 2 AP/UW classes are recommended. Refer to AP, UW and Honors registration procedure sheet, which lists application procedures
- Students may register for Peer Tutor as a course selection
- Peer Tutor, TA and Organization are elective credits
- Refer to the Dual Credit chart for courses that count for credit in two subject areas
- Student Store requires an application to enroll and cannot be listed on the registration worksheet. Place an * next to the course they would like removed if admitted to the Student Store. Applications are available at the store and must be turned in to the student store to be considered
- **Remind students that we will not make class changes next year if they want to drop and class that they requested including alternates so they should choose wisely**
