- High School & Beyond Plan (HSBP) is a graduation requirement
- Xello is the new program used for HSBP, formerly known as Career Cruising
- Designed for students to begin career exploration within their high school experience
- Using Xello will help students to link their personality, skills, and interests to potential career options and understand how those career aspirations can be achieved through proper course selection
- All assigned activities are grade-specific and need to be completed to stay on track with HSBP requirements
- Activity make-ups will be done during a future Wolf Time, if not completed during registration time

Understand Before Getting Started

- Xello and the grade-assigned lessons are new as of this 2018-2019 school year.
- Therefore, students only complete the three grade-assigned lessons appropriate for their grade; no need to go back and do previous grade lessons despite the fact you can see them and will show as 'incomplete'.
 - Students are always welcome to complete if interested, but it will not be required.
- For example, a 12th grader will see all of the 9th-11th grade lessons on their page and it will show as 'incomplete'. It is NOT required of 12th graders to go back and do those lessons only the three grade-assigned lessons.




