# Advanced Placement (AP)

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- EHS has over 22 AP Courses to select from
- Prerequisites for AP courses vary but typically require a "B" average or higher in your current class
- Students will be prepared to take the AP course exam in the spring. High test scores may earn college credit



# College in the High School

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- College level courses taught by EHS teachers at EHS
- Students pay tuition to receive college credit for the course
- UW college courses include:
  - Astronomy 101 and 150 (Register as a year-long course)
  - Calculus 124, Calculus 125, and Precalculus 120
  - Composition 131
  - Comparative Literature 240 Margins and Centers: Who's In, Who's Out and Why it Matters to All of Us
  - Psychology 101



# Running Start

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- To qualify you must be a junior or senior who is on track for graduation
- Choose part-time or full-time enrollment at the college
- Attend Bellevue College, Cascadia College, Central Washington University Sammamish, or Lake Washington Institute of Technology



# Next Steps

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- Register for classes at EHS as if you were going to be a full-time EHS student next year
- Pick up an EHS Running Start Agreement form in the Counseling Center
- Attend an Information session at the college with your parent to learn more and determine if Running Start is a good fit for you
- Schedule an Orientation at the college of your choice to learn how to get started with the application process
- You will meet with your high school counselor in early May to sign the Running Start Enrollment Verification Form (RSEVF) and adjust your EHS course requests



# CTE Dual Credit

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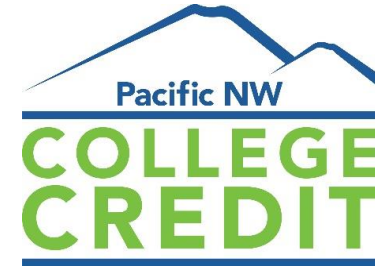
- **Earn dual high school and college credit through Pacific NW College Credit** (formerly Tech Prep) for courses taught at EHS by earning a B or better and paying a \$50 fee.
- **Credit articulates to a local community college**, which can sometimes be transferred to 4-year institutions

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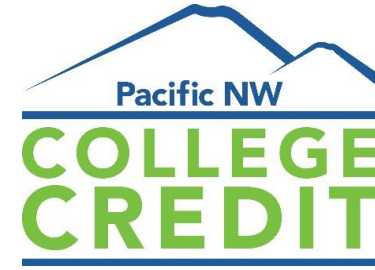
