# Math is Cool Competition - Congratulations Eastlake!

Students from the Eastlake chapter of the Mu Alpha Theta math honor society, sponsored by Mr. Gregory Emerson, competed in the Math Is Cool regional competition on October 28. Despite competing with just three members of a four-person team, the Eastlake team of Amay Bansal, Daniel Dickman, and Pranav Krovvidi won first place in the grades 9 and 10 team competition. In the individual competitions, Neha Dalia scored highest for Eastlake in Calculus, Amay Bansal scored highest for Eastlake in Pre-Calculus, and Daniel Dickman scored highest for Eastlake in Algebra 2.

## Attendance

After winning the regional competition, Eastlake was invited to compete in the statewide Math Is Cool Masters competition in Moses Lake on November 18. Again competing with just three members, the Eastlake team finished second in the statewide grades 9 and 10 team competition. In the statewide individual competitions, Amay Bansal placed fifth in Pre-Calculus, Pranav Krovvidi placed thirteenth in Algebra 2, and Daniel Dickman placed second in Algebra 2.



- Students should be appropriately dressed to meet the school dress code.

- Be sure to complete ALL requested fields so the image is assigned to the correct student.
