Principal Message

Dear Wolves,

Eastlake has a holistic perspective on education, and a common goal to support students in their development of character and citizenship. We not only teach students to think but to act and interact in a healthy and helpful manner. We want to help students conduct themselves responsibly and with integrity. We want students to understand the importance of personal wellness, where ambition and competition are not at the expense of each other, or one's own mental health. We want to not only put students in groups to learn, but teach them to learn as a group.

Research suggests that performance character such as work ethic and the ability to persevere through challenge are more predictive of long term success than GPA and SAT, so we help students form habits, that will then form them for the rest of their lives. In Grade 9, we teach skills such as organization and note-taking. These students also learn time-management and the importance of goal setting, progress monitoring and reflection, because we know that sometimes it's about working smarter, and not just harder.

Through classroom content and instruction, students learn the importance of civic engagement and social justice. Students also learn about the biology of the teenage brain and how it connects to learning and decision making.

We make a plan, and take intentional steps to help students become better people and more productive citizens.

- Students should be appropriately dressed to meet the school dress code.
- Digital images should be at least 300 dpi and in a .jpg, .tiff or eps format - Word, excel, publisher or other formats will not be accepted.
- Be sure to complete ALL requested fields so the image is assigned to the correct student.
