It's almost time to register for next year's courses. Eastlake High School offers a broad selection of rigorous Advanced Placement and University of Washington opportunities. Please join us in the theater on January 29th to learn about them.

Eastlake's DECA chapter reached a record high of 190 members this year, making it one of the largest clubs at EHS. DECA prepares students to become leaders and entrepreneurs in the business world. Eastlake DECA is advised by Mrs. Petersen, Mrs. Stevens, and Mr. Ward. The student officer team consists of presidents Nicole Kim and Matthieu Le, and vice-presidents Swathi Narayan, Jack Pendleton and Laura Wang.

On Friday, January 10th, Eastlake DECA members competed against 1,700 other students at the annual Area competition in Bellevue. During competition, contestants presented to expert judges in various case studies and written events, taking on the roles of business executives and entrepreneurs in hopes of joining the 400 students moving on to the WA DECA State competition. 68 Eastlake students placed in the Top 10 of their events and qualified for State in March (another record).
