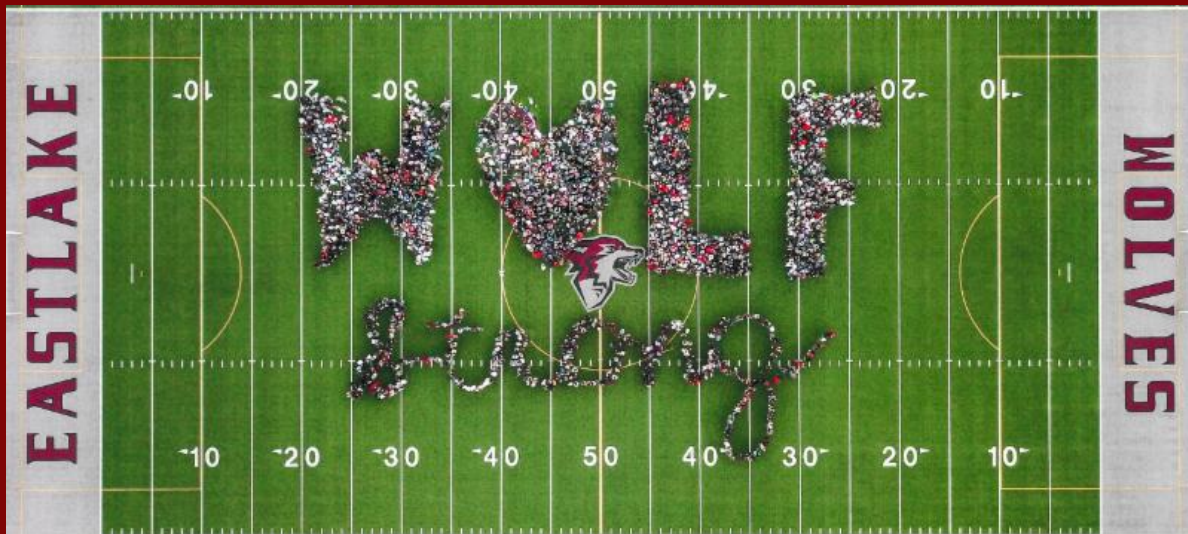

Semester 2 Parking Permits

On January 10th, a record 142 members of Eastlake's DECA chapter competed at the annual Area Competition in Bellevue. During competition, contestants presented to judges in various role play and written events, taking on the roles of business executives and entrepreneurs. 49 members were recognized at the awards ceremony, 37 of which placed in the Top 8 of their events, qualifying for the State Competition in March.
