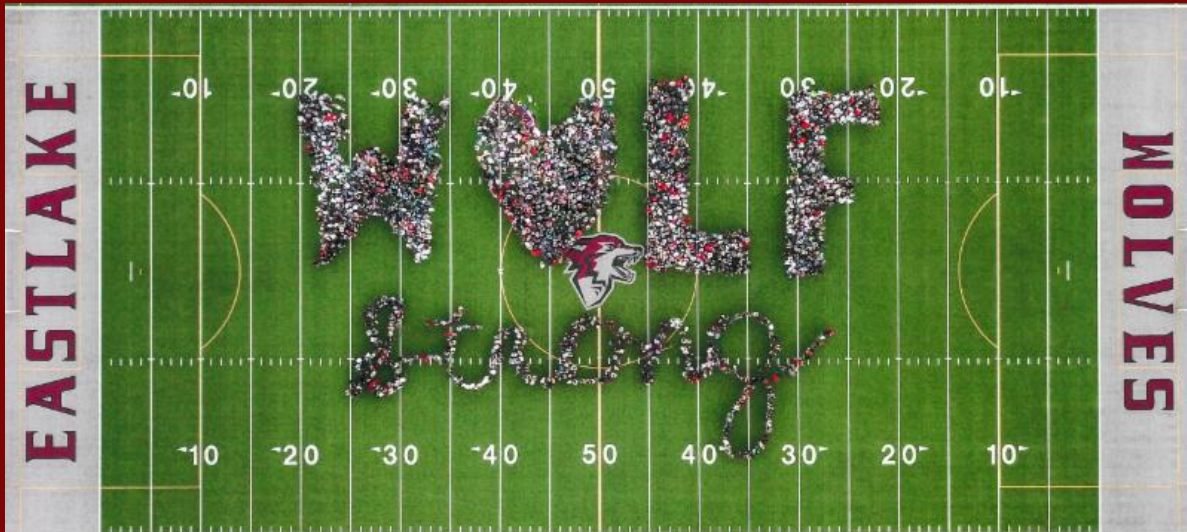

Class Fees Not Paid Yet?

Families can check on Parent Access to see if their students have any fines.

Steps to View or Pay Fees/Fines Online:

- Go to www.lwsd.org
- Select Find it Fast from top right
- Select Pay Fees Online
- Login to Parent Access
- Select Student's Name
- Fine/Fee message will automatically pop up, select to view/pay online.

Fees/Fines can be paid by credit card through Parent Access or by cash or check if you pay at the bookkeepers window. If class fees pose a hardship contact your student's counselor for financial assistance.

- Fever over 100 degrees Fahrenheit

- Diarrhea
- Severe cough
- Sore throat
- Oozing rashes or sores
- Eye infection

Of course, if your child has any of the above symptoms, please keep them home from school to prevent the spread of illness.
