Panorama Survey

As you are aware, growing our students' social-emotional ("SEL") skills is an important goal for our school. As part of these activities, we survey students and ask them to reflect on their own mindsets and approaches to learning. The data we get back helps us continue to identify opportunities for growth and development with our students.

We partner with a leader in the SEL space, Panorama Education. Panorama develops tools to empower schools and districts to learn about students' self-perceptions, better understand student experiences in their learning environment, and identify opportunities to enhance support of teachers and counselors as they implement SEL programs.

Panorama's SEL survey is grouped into three categories:

- Student competencies
- Student supports and environment
- Teacher skills and perspectives

These surveys will help shape the Lake Washington School District's approach to supporting teachers' work in service of the whole student.

Equity at Eastlake

"In the U.S., most people strictly think African American when they hear of someone who is 'Black,' but according to the Slave Voyages project, during the colonial period, about 15 times as many slaves were taken to Latin America than the United States." (ABC News, Pew Research Center)

As we continue to honor National Hispanic and Latino Heritage Month, we will highlight the intersectionality between Latinos and African Americans. Brazil and Colombia have the largest Black populations in Latin America. The Black population in Brazil is the largest outside of Nigeria and its culture has been infused into worldwide celebrations like carnival. Carnival in Rio de Janeiro is celebrated by over 5 million people and is famous for its parades which feature singing, dancing, wearing masks and costumes, all of which have roots in African culture. Colombia has a large Black population because slaves were brought to and distributed from the ports in Cartagena. Blacks played a significant role in Colombian independence from Spain; over half of the men who fought for independence were Black.

Being Black and being Latino are not mutually exclusive; a quarter of Latinos in the United States self-identify as Afro-Latino, Afro-Caribbean or Latino with African descent. When Latinos use the phrase, Las Vidas Negras Importan, Black Lives Matter in Spanish, they are not only expressing their support for Black Americans, but also demanding justice for their own Black Lives. Steps to register and purchase AP tests.

- Select Your Student's name
- Select Shop- Items At Student's School
- Select AP Testing
- Scroll down to see all AP Test options, click BUY for the tests your student wants to take. Click [HERE](#) for a complete list of test names.
- Click the shopping cart in the top right corner when ready to check out
- Complete payment info and print receipt as a confirmation of your payment/registration
