Dear Wolves,

We have had a successful Homecoming week that will culminate with a football game against Skyline on Friday and a Homecoming Dance on Saturday. Our students worked to build school spirit and a sense of community that will resonate well beyond the week. Several years ago, we changed Homecoming Royalty to "Homecoming Heroes", allowing the entire school to vote for which student they think best represents the values of Eastlake High School. Each student has the opportunity to receive recognition for their character and contributions to our school.

For the Homecoming Dance, leadership students have put in a lot of effort so that their classmates will not only want to attend the dance, but stay for the duration. If a student never arrives or chooses to leave the dance early, they are no longer supervised. Please know where your students are before the dance, when they leave the dance and where they go after the dance.

Although we have safety concerns about "party buses", we understand that some students will still arrive on these buses. When the buses arrive at Eastlake, we will require all students to exit the bus and enter the school dance. Students cannot stay on the bus on our campus. If they remain on the bus, the bus may be subject to a search. When students leave the dance, they cannot return, so students arriving on a bus need to coordinate with each other on their departure time.

We also have safety concerns about the "after parties" and have dealt with several situations where kids find themselves in compromising situations, usually after consuming alcohol, and even when the parents are home.

Please support our efforts to keep kids safe during Homecoming.

The day of the Test

- You will find your room assignment posted in the commons. Show up early to see what room you will test in and make sure you find your way there by 7:30
- Cell phones are not permitted near the test.

Helpful Information about the Test

- The PSAT is essentially a gateway to doing well on the SAT.
- Your PSAT score can predict your SAT score. The test essentially shows you how well you'd perform on the SAT if you were to take it at that exact moment in time.
- All juniors who take the PSAT are automatically entered into the National Merit Scholarship Program, which awards annual \$2,500 scholarships to top scorers.
- You don't lose points for wrong answers, but you do lose points for skipped answers. Random guessing won't do much for your score, but if you can make an educated guess (where you eliminate at least one of your answer choices), you can boost your chances of getting the question right.
- Get a good night's sleep!
- Don't stress about this test... it's practice!

Lake Washington School District Implements New Volunteer System

This summer, Lake Washington School District's volunteer application system was transferred to a volunteer system developed by Raptor Technologies, Inc. Raptor is used across the nation in many school districts and is considered the industry leader.

Information for all current volunteers has been transferred into the new volunteer system. If you are still within your two-year approval window, you do not need to reapply. The renewal window opens 30 days before your expiration date. Volunteers can now renew through the [district website](#) instead of logging into Parent Access.

If you are an approved volunteer, you have access to a [volunteer portal with Raptor](#). If you are wondering when your volunteer application expires, you can find this information on your profile. Use your email address for the username and if you don't already have a password, click "Forgot my Password." This will help you reset the account password. Your "renewal window" opens thirty days before your application is due to expire and you should receive an email from Raptor reminding you to renew with instructions on how to do so.

Remember, this time of year we receive a large volume of volunteer applications. It can take up to two weeks to process an application.
