The Library of Congress just released 3 new education apps. Below are the two that are good for middle and high school students:

- Eagle Eye Citizen, developed by the Roy Rosenzweig Center for History and New Media at George Mason University. Eagle Eye Citizen engages middle and high school students in solving and creating interactive challenges on American history, civics and government with Library of Congress primary sources in order to develop their civic understanding and historical thinking skills.
- Engaging Congress, developed by Indiana University Center on Representative Government. Engaging Congress is a series of game-based learning activities that explores the basic tenets of representative government and the challenges it faces in contemporary society. Primary-source documents are used to examine the history and evolution of issues that confront Congress today.

Attendance Scenario -

Scenario -Your student comes to Eastlake a few minutes (or more) after the tardy bell rings. The teacher has already taken attendance and your student was marked ABSENT. The teacher is in the middle of teaching and forgets to change the ABSENT into a TARDY. You then get an automated call saying that

your child missed their class, when, in fact, they were only late.

Answer - If your student is tardy to school they need to check in at the Attendance office before going to class. Then I can change the ABSENCE into a tardy and that will prevent an automated call to your home during the dinner hour.

Please adhere to the following guidelines:



- Images should be "portrait" style with head and shoulders showing.
- Please DO NOT submit landscape photos!
- The head should be approximately 1/2 the total width of the photo.
- Avoid accessories such as cars, animals, weapons, musical instruments.
- Students should be appropriately dressed to meet the school dress code.
- Digital images should be at least 300 dpi and in a .jpg, .tiff or eps format - Word, excel, publisher or other formats will not be accepted.
- Be sure to complete ALL requested fields so the image is assigned to the correct student.
