Laptop Roll in for 9th - 11th Grade Heads Up:

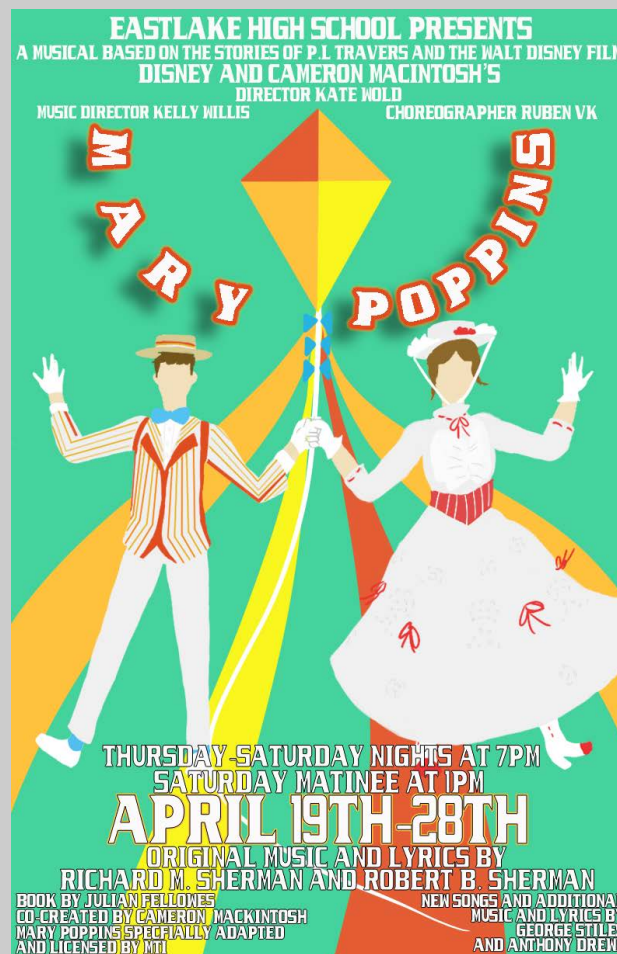
Laptop Roll in for 9th - 11th Grade Heads Up: This year the dates/times from Laptop Roll In for 9th - 11th graders are Tuesday June 19th and Wednesday

June 20th in the EHS Library from 9:00am - 2:00pm. Below are ways that parents can help students be successful with laptop turn in this year. Students will receive more information and a video in Homeroom when these dates get closer.

- * If you know your student will be ending the school year early please tell them to turn in their laptops early. We can arrange for a tech to inspect their laptop BEFORE the official roll in dates but not AFTER.
 - * If an emergency arises and your student is unable to make it to school on the laptop roll in day try to see if someone (neighbor/friend) can bring the laptop to the EHS Library before 2:00pm on June 19th or June 20th.
 - * Make sure your student has seen the Laptop Roll in Video. This should be shown to them in Homeroom by Monday June 11th. A copy will be posted on the EHS Library Power School page if they miss seeing it for any reason.
 - * The deadline for students to sign up for a laptop turn in time in Flexi Sched will be Friday June 15th, so asking them if they have done this would be great!
 - * If anything happens to prevent your student from turning in their laptop during the time in Flexi Sched, as long as we get it before 2:00pm on Wednesday June 20th that's fine.
