## Technology

### Laptop Repairs

Students and parents, hopefully your student laptop will work well while our schools are closed. However, if it doesn't then please follow this process:

- Report the broken laptop to [ftaccess@lwsd.org](mailto:ftaccess@lwsd.org) Include student name, school tag number on laptop, description of problem, your phone number.
- A technician will acknowledge and will inform you that a replacement is being prepared.
- Eastlake staff will call you to arrange a drop off and/or pick up date and time
- The student drops off the broken laptop and picks up a replacement. Students and staff will maintain social distancing and will not be close to each other. We have a laptop station just inside the main entrance to our school to minimize the student's time in the building.
- **VERY IMPORTANT!** The student must log onto the laptop before leaving the building or it won't work at home!

### Eastlake Students Win Big at Annual Regional/State Science Fair

On March 27-28, 5 Eastlake students competed at the annual WA State Science & Engineering Fair (WSSEF), which was joined with the Central Sound Regional Science and Engineering Fair (CSRSEF). Due to health concerns, the fair was held virtually for the first time in 63 years, but that didn't stop Eastlake students from performing exceptionally!

Out of 210+ high school research projects from across the state, Eastlake students brought home a total of four first place category awards and one second place category

award. Additionally, for the first time in history, two Eastlake students were awarded CSRSEF Grand Champion awards (given to the top five central sound regional projects at the fair), and WSSEF's Gold and Silver Grand Champion awards (given to the top two projects in the state). These two students will represent WA State as part of the 2020 Washington International Science and Engineering (WISE) Team this year and as 2020 Regeneron International Science and Engineering Fair (ISEF) Finalists. Regeneron ISEF is the world's most prestigious international high school science competition, recognizing 1,800 of the world's brightest young scientists and innovators annually.

Eastlake's winning students, alphabetically by last name, are as follows:

- Audrey Gruian, sophomore, was named WSSEF Silver Grand Champion and CSRSEF Grand Champion for her project "ALV+IN: And Intelligent Stereoscopic Olfactory System for Autonomous Localization of Volatile Organic Compounds". Audrey received a first place Robotics and Intelligent Machines category award as well.
- Aryan Mahindra, junior, received a second place Robotics and Intelligent Machines category award for his project "Dynamic Mesh Networks for Automobiles".
- Natasha Murugan, sophomore, received a first place Cellular and Molecular Biology category award for her project "Analyzing Immunoabsorption Proteins for Treatment of Dilated Cardiomyopathy".
- Nathan Yap, sophomore, received a first place Animal Science category award for his project "An Investigation of the Uricolytic Processes of Pogonomymex Barbatulus Worker Ant Endosymbiotic Bacteria".
- Christine Ye, sophomore, was named WSSEF Gold Grand Champion and CSRSEF Grand Champion for her project, "Novel Surveys of Substructure in Pulsar Glitch Morphology and Glitching Pulsar Populations". Christine received a first place Physics and Astronomy category award as well.

### **Eastlake Student Selected as Washington State Thespian Officer**

Congratulations to Ava Berkau who was selected to be a Washington State Thespian Officer! She was chosen for her strong leadership skills shown by her responsibility leading EHS Drama Club as an officer and learning from Ms. Millet's leadership class.
