Next year's fall musical, *The Addams Family*, will have auditions on May 30th. Students can sign up for an audition slot in Mrs. Wold's room C226. Students should have a one minute comedic monologue that comes from a play and 16 bars of a song prepared for auditions. Callbacks will be May 31st and June 1st. Rehearsals will begin in September and students cast will be enrolled in the after school class, Production Workshop.



State Testing May 21 - 24

State testing for Eastlake students will be May 21-24. Click [here](#) for a special testing schedule for the four testing days, and a normal Friday schedule for May 25th. Information regarding state tests can be found below. Eastlake's state testing will not include any freshmen but will include every sophomore, every junior, and a few seniors. More details for each grade level are found below.

Early next week each student who is scheduled for a test will receive a personal email with information about that test. In one week every student who takes a bus will receive a personal email that explains what time the bus will arrive at their bus stop. Buses will arrive at the normal times for students taking the tests, and a second bus run will be 2 ½ hours later for students who do not take tests.

Students at Eastlake will be tested on the following dates:

May 21-22: 7:30-10:20, SBA ELA testing for parts 1 and 2. Classes start at 10:30, this is a two-day test

May 21 or 22: 7:30 - 10:20, SCAS Science testing. Classes start at 10:30, this is a one-day test

May 23: 7:30 -10:20, SBA Math testing part 1. Classes start at 10:30, this is a two-day test

May 24: 7:30 -9:45, SBA Math testing part 2. Classes start at 9:50

Who needs to take these tests?

SBA ELA - All 10th grade students and any 11th/12th grade students that have not yet met the proficiency requirement. Last year juniors were required to take this test, and sophomores could opt in. Now it's a sophomore-level test.

SBA Math - All 10th grade students and any 11th/12th grade students that have not yet met the proficiency requirement. This test also transitioned from juniors last year to sophomores this year.

WCAS Science - All 11th grade students. The one-day Washington Comprehensive Assessment of Science replaced the Biology End of Course test (Bio EOC) as our state's required science test. All juniors are required to take this test even if they have a passing score on the Bio EOC.

What if a student is absent?

We will have make-up testing starting at 1:00 on the next two Wednesdays: May 30 and June 6. If students do not pass then they will have more opportunities next year.

How do I know if my student has already passed?

- 12th grade: A few seniors have not taken the SBA ELA and we are contacting them individually.
- 11th grade: All juniors are required to take the WCAS. To check for the SBA ELA and the SBA Math go to Skyward, select Test Results on the left side of the screen, and if you see SBA then click to see if your son/daughter passed.
- 10th grade: All sophomores are required to take the SBA ELA and SBA Math tests.
- 9th grade: Freshmen are not allowed to take any test yet, even if they'd like to.

What to Bring to the Test

- Computer and charger
- Earbuds
- Computer mouse (optional)
- Water and a snack
- Book to read when finished. Homework that does not involve a laptop is also OK.

Regular and Late Bus Routes

- Buses will arrive at all bus stops at the normal times on testing days, for students who need to take state tests.
- Buses will also make a late run on testing days, for students who are not scheduled to take state tests this year. The exact times will be sent to students and parents prior to testing.

To earn college credit, students must [register](#) while taking the class, pay the non-refundable \$46 annual consortium fee by June 15TH, and receive a grade of "B" or higher in the class.
