Dear Wolves:

Eastlake incorporates student voice into our continuous improvement plans. We had 826 students respond to the survey about remote learning. As a staff we will review this data and use it to inform future remote learning.

Overall, 29 percent of students stated they feel overwhelmed all the time and 57 percent stated they feel overwhelmed most of the time. Forty percent stated that they are spending more time on school than before the closure.

We have reiterated the expectations to staff around student work. Students are expected to engage with this learning and will have approximately 3-5 hours of assigned learning each day. This will include approximately 30-45 min per class per day or 15-25 hours/week.

We also understand that many students have found it difficult staying organized. We have reminded staff about the importance of uploading student work by Monday, preferably in the morning. Although teachers have discretion on the technology platforms they use, we have shared the importance of being clear and concise about what is due when and where in order to help students stay organized. We have also encouraged teachers to continue providing flexibility for students on due dates, giving them multiple days to complete assignments.

Many students also shared why they have not consistently participated in Office Hours. Most shared that they did not think they needed help. Although this may be true for some students, one difficulty high school students often have is knowing what they don't know. Perhaps this is a good topic for parents to discuss with your kids and could help encourage them to participate more frequently in Office Hours.

This remote learning thing is the epitome of get started and get better!
