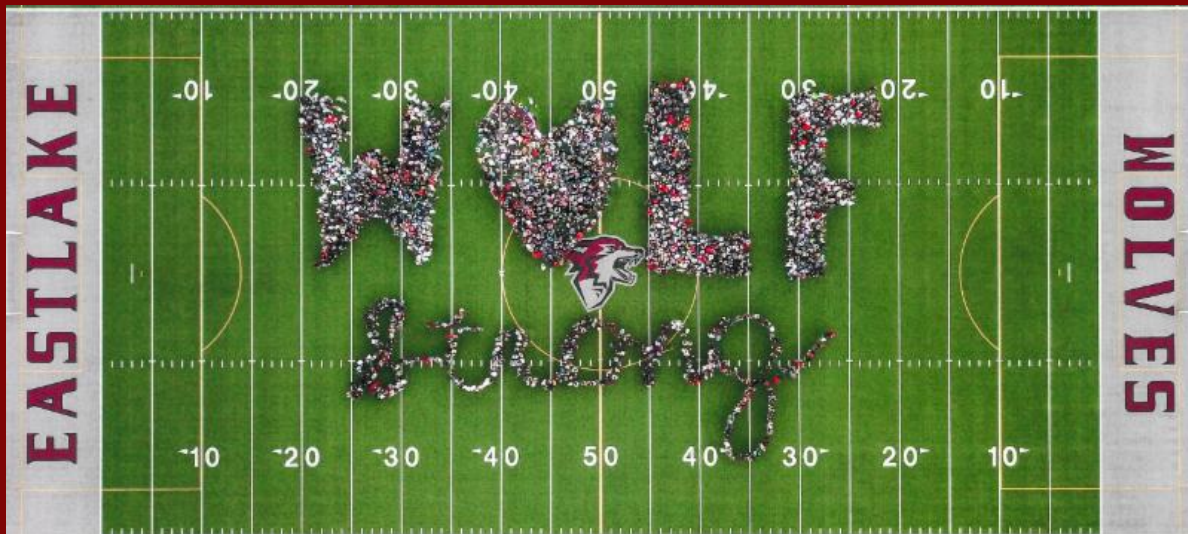

Fall Play - My Fair Lady Auditions

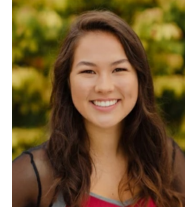
