Two major undertakings in these final weeks are not only completing schoolwork but collecting school materials from all students in Grades 9-11.

Below is information about the **final dates to assign and turn in schoolwork**.

Grades 9-11:

Monday, June 8 – Last day to post student work/assignments for grades 9-11

- June 8 – 12: Student work/assignment completion
- June 15-19: Student work/assignment completion and end of year connections

Friday June 19: All high school report cards must be completed by teachers by midnight

Grade 12:

Monday, June 1 – Last day to post new student work/assignments for grade 12

- June 1 – 5: Student work/assignment completion
- June 8 – 12: Student work/assignment completion

Friday June 19: All high school report cards must be completed by teachers by midnight

We will be **collecting school materials** from all students in Grades 9-12. Students will be turning in computers, computer chargers, textbooks, library books and sports uniforms on their designated day and time. Students will also pick up their locker contents at this time. Student in grades 9-11 may keep their library books over the summer.

Eastlake Finals:

Our current Office Hour schedule will be the same for the final weeks of school. Teachers may ask students to continue with curriculum or ask students to complete some culminating assessment or project. However, this work must fit within the given parameters of being asynchronous and taking approximately 30-45 min per class per day.

The week of June 1-5 is Senior Finals Week and June 8-12 is Finals Week for Grades 9-11.

Eastlake is Open for Students on Mondays and Fridays:

As a reminder, students can come into Eastlake every Monday from 11-2 and every Friday from 9-12 to pick up or drop off assignments and supplies for their classes.

Medication Pick-up Monday June 1st & Friday June 5th:

This is a friendly reminder that the medication pick up days are next Monday (June 1st) from 11-2 and next Friday (June 5th) from 9-12. You may pick up your students medication/supplies anytime on either day.

Student Roll In:

Roll In is our way of saying, time to turn everything in! Students can check their own Library account any time to see what books, textbooks, and laptop items they have checked out to them.. The Library checkout system is called [Destiny](#). Directions for how to do this are here or on the Eastlake Library Power School site at the top. This is a great way to prepare for roll in so you can see what is checked out to you, compare the barcodes, and be prepared to bring them to roll in. For seniors all items are due. For grades 9-11 Library Books may be kept over the summer, but you will need to turn in your laptop, charger, and textbooks. All students can use these directions to see what is on your account and check that the barcodes are correct. If you notice the barcodes are different please email Mrs. Story at kastory@lwsd.org.

2019-20 Yearbooks:

Yearbooks will be distributed in June, details will be available soon. Right now please check to see if you have purchased a Yearbook for your student, follow these steps:

- Login to www.lwsd.org and select Find It Fast from the top right corner
- Select 'Pay Fees Online' and then select 'Online Payments' and then enter login info
- Then select your student's name, then under Reports- select Purchase History
- From here scroll and use the arrows at the top to see a full history of all purchases made. If you see the item EHS YEARBOOK 2019-20 then you have purchased a Yearbook this year.

AP Refunds

- Student and families do not need to do anything right now if they wish to withdraw from an AP Test and get a refund.
- Students should not sit or submit materials for any AP Test that they wish to cancel. Refunds will be processed automatically after we receive rosters from AP College Board.
- If you paid for a test but are not on the roster, we will issue a refund. Refunds will be \$96 per test, checks will be mailed over the summer to the address on record for your student.
- The refund process will take extra time due to the large refund requests, thank you for your patience.
