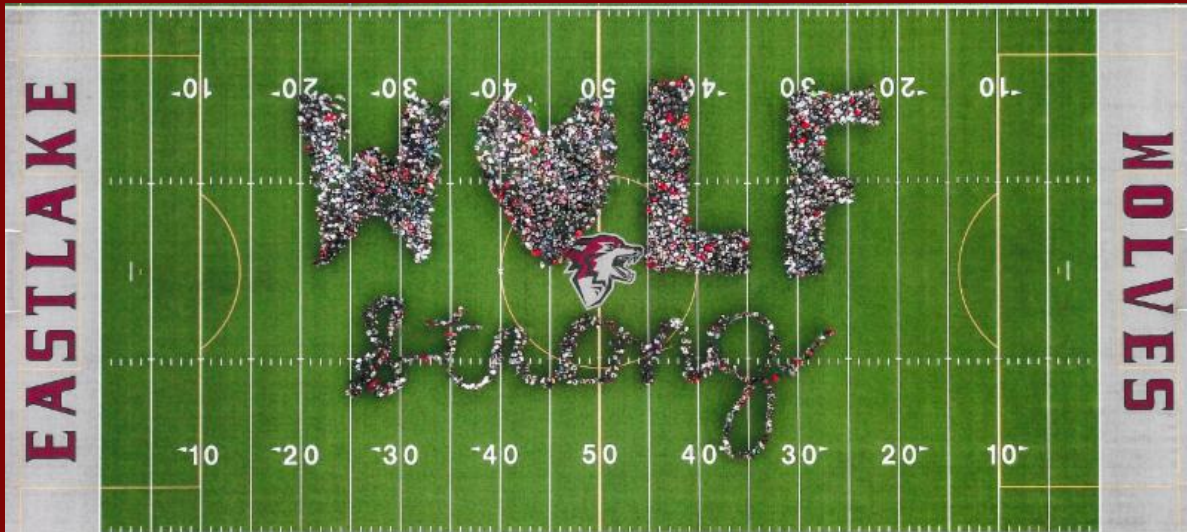

DECA Competes in International Career Development Conference

Twenty-nine Eastlake students competed at the DECA International Career Development Conference 2019, from April 26th to May 1st. ICDC 2019 was held in Orlando, Florida, and attracted over 18,000 members from the 50 states, Canada, and nine other countries. The Eastlake team was led by officers Sanjana Sridhar, Josh Steckler, Megha Mattikalli, Matthieu Le, and Nicole Kim, and by its two dedicated advisors, Mrs. Petersen and Mrs. Stevens.

The top qualifiers from each state earned the right to compete at this prestigious

conference, vying to be the top contenders for international awards. Each event boasted a pool of around 200 competitors or teams, seven of which represented Washington. This was a record-breaking year for Eastlake DECA, with more ICDC qualifiers than ever before.

After the primary round of competitions, Megha Mattikalli, Preksha Mittal, and the team of Mac Steckler, Preju Kanuparth, and Jack Titus qualified as international finalists, placing in the top ten percent of their events. Riya Yerramilli also earned an award for top role play. Following event finals, Steckler, Kanuparth and Titus earned seventh place in Learn and Earn Project, while Mattikalli earned third place in Hotel and Lodging Management, receiving the highly coveted DECA glass trophy. Mattikalli is the second student in Eastlake history to win the DECA glass.
