Are you taking an AP exam?

AP Testing is May 7th-11th and May 14th-18th. Check your AP Packet for your testing location, date, and time. For any morning tests show up by 7am and for afternoon tests show up by 11:30am to give yourself plenty of time to check in and get settled. Carpooling is encouraged as students from Tesla STEM will be testing at Eastlake as well. Please carpool and arrive early.

Students should make sure they bring picture ID (they cannot be admitted without it), AP Packet, calculators (if appropriate for the test and is the correct kind for that test), #2 pencils, dark blue or black ink pen, a snack and drink in clear plastic bags for breaks, and nothing else. Proctors are not responsible for bringing extras of any of these items, so if you do not provide them you run the risk of not having the correct tools for your AP test. Mechanical pencils and erasers (except for those on pencils) are not allowed. Any watches with beepers, calculators, access to the internet, etc. are not allowed. Any wearable technology is not allowed.

NO CELL PHONES OR OTHER ELECTRONIC DEVICES - You may not bring cell phones, net books, other lap tops, e-readers, ipods, or any other electronics into the testing room. If you bring any of these items with you, it will be held in a box by the test proctors and they are not responsible for the return of these items. If you are caught with any electronic devices during a test, the test will be confiscated and the student dismissed from the test site. College Board is strict on this.

Yearbook Distribution is Coming - June 7th

State Testing May 21 - 24

Students at Eastlake will be tested on the following dates:

May 21-22: 7:30-10:20, SBA ELA testing for parts 1 and 2. Classes start at 10:30, this is a two-day test

May 21 or 22: 7:30 - 10:20, SCAS Science testing. Classes start at 10:30, this is a one-day test

May 23: 7:30 -10:20, SBA Math testing part 1. Classes start at 10:30, this is a two-day test

May 24: 7:30 -9:45, SBA Math testing part 2. Classes start at 9:50

Who needs to take these tests?

SBA ELA - All 10th grade students and any 11th/12th grade students that have not yet met the proficiency requirement. Last year juniors were required to take this test, and sophomores could opt in. Now it's a sophomore-level test.

SBA Math - All 10th grade students and any 11th/12th grade students that have not yet met the proficiency requirement. This test also transitioned from juniors last year to sophomores this year.

WCAS Science - All 11th grade students. The one-day Washington Comprehensive Assessment of Science replaced the Biology End of Course test (Bio EOC) as our state's required science test. All juniors are required to take this test even if they have a passing score on the Bio EOC.

What if a student is absent?

We will have make-up testing starting at 1:00 on the next two Wednesdays: May 30 and June 6. If students do not pass then they will have more opportunities next year.

How do I know if my student has already passed?

- 12th grade: A few seniors have not taken the SBA ELA and we are contacting them individually.
- 11th grade: All juniors are required to take the WCAS. To check for the SBA ELA and the SBA Math go to Skyward, select Test Results on the left side of the screen, and if you see SBA then click to see if your son/daughter passed.
- 10th grade: All sophomores are required to take the SBA ELA and SBA Math tests.
- 9th grade: Freshmen are not allowed to take any test yet, even if they'd like to.

What to Bring to the Test

- Computer and charger
- Earbuds
- Computer mouse (optional)
- Water and a snack

- Book to read when finished. Homework that does not involve a laptop is also OK.

Regular and Late Bus Routes

- Buses will arrive at all bus stops at the normal times on testing days, for students who need to take state tests.
- Buses will also make a late run on testing days, for students who are not scheduled to take state tests this year. The exact times will be sent to students and parents prior to testing.
