PE Credit Options

In accordance with state law, individual students may be excused from participating in physical education under certain circumstances. Such excused students shall be required to demonstrate proficiency/competency in the knowledge portion of the fitness requirement through participation in a district-approved and administered assessment or fitness plan. The dates that these options will be offered for 2018-19 will be posted by June 30 on the [district website](#). Students in the Class of 2019 and 2020 who choose the Fitness Plan option will be able to download directions for the fall submission at the end of June.

New LWSD Volunteer System

This summer, Lake Washington School District's volunteer application system will be transferred from its current system to a volunteer system developed by Raptor Technologies, Inc. Raptor is used across the nation in many school districts and is considered the industry leader.

Information for all current volunteers will be transferred into the new volunteer system. Instead of logging in to Parent Access, parents will log in to the Raptor system to complete and update their volunteer applications.

The volunteer application system will have a blackout window for a period of time over the summer while the system is updated to Raptor. More information about the Raptor volunteer system will be available prior to the start of the 2018-19 school year.

Eastlake Alumni Spotlight

Mason Starr, a 2015 Eastlake graduate offered to stop by Mr. Retzlaff's AP physics and UW Astronomy classes to present on his research related to the Mar's rovers. Mason has become involved in an undergraduate research program at Western Washington University that does spectral analysis of images taken by the Opportunity rover. Mason analyses the images as soon as they are downloaded from the rover and is on the front lines of analyzing the images through "Reflectance Spectroscopy". This is a technique student learn about here at Eastlake in UW Astronomy thanks to a grant from the PTSA that supplied the reflectance spectrometers! Mason was able to share some interesting insights into the physics, image processing and politics that are involved in Mar's research. His ability to show and communicate to the current high school students that undergraduates can get involved in significant research of real consequence was very inspiring. This summer he will be continuing his research related to the rover images as well as traveling down to Arizona State University to potentially do some calibration work on the Mars 2020 rover to be launched in a couple of years. Hats off to Mason!

2018-19 College Essay Prompts

Summer is a great time for rising seniors to get started on their college essays. Check out the 2018-19 Essay Prompts for [The Common Application](#) and [The Coalition Application](#). Some schools, the [University of California schools](#), use their own application portal and essay questions. Some schools, like Washington State University, do not require an essay under most circumstances. Check with your target schools for application requirements and consider finishing the summer with a draft. Look for essay and application support in Fall Wolf Time sessions as well as Senior English classes.

Letters of Recommendation

Not all schools require Letters of Recommendation but for those that do, students should plan ahead. Ask 4-6 weeks before you need it and consider working on the [Teacher](#) and [Counselor](#) Letter of Recommendation Forms as needed over the summer. Keep in mind that Letters of Recommendation are also often needed for scholarships.

UW Fall 2018 Application

Calling all future University of Washington applicants! The UW application opens on September 1st with a deadline of November 15th. UW will use the [Coalition for Access, Affordability and Success application portal](#) again this year. Students can begin planning their application essays by reviewing the Coalition's [essay prompts and short response supplement](#). Eastlake will host a University of Washington information session and application working sessions for students during Wolf Time on Friday, September 21st.
