### Eastlake Finals:

Our current Office Hour schedule will be the same for the final weeks of school. Teachers may ask students to continue with curriculum or ask students to complete some culminating assessment or project. However, this work must fit within the given parameters of being asynchronous and taking approximately 30-45 min per class per day.

Seniors have completed their finals. June 8-12 is Finals Week for Grades 9-11.

### Eastlake is Open for Students on Mondays and Fridays:

As a reminder, students can come into Eastlake every Monday from 11-2 and every Friday from 9-12 to pick up or drop off assignments and supplies for their classes.

### Second Semester Grades

As a reminder, at the end of this semester your transcript will show either an A or Incomplete for your current classes. Your transcript will not show any grades of B, C, D, or F. At the end of second semester, students enrolled in credit-bearing high school courses who have a passing grade in the Skyward gradebook for the semester will be assigned an "A" with a COVID-19 designation for each course completed. This means any grade above 60% will be converted to an A with the COVID-19 designation. Any grade that is not an A will be an Incomplete.

### June 16-18 Student Check-Out for Grades 9-11:

Students in Grades 9-11 will check-in school materials such as their laptop, charger and textbooks on June 16-18 during their designated timeslot. They will also pick-up Yearbooks and the contents from their hallway and PE lockers. Students need to wear a mask and maintain social distancing. Masks will be available for students who do not bring their own.

Students will arrive on campus during their designated timeslot and wait in their cars until prompted to enter the building.

Additional materials that students may need to return include library books, sports uniform, band uniform or a checked-out calculator or camera from class. Students may also need to pick-up Art or AVID boxes.

The last day for teachers to assign work for students in Grades 9-11 will be Monday,

June 8. Students will be completing assignments and assessments during the week of June 8 -12. If necessary, students have until June 19 to turn in missing assignments and can therefore turn in their school materials at that time as well.

In order to collect all materials in a safe manner that aligns with social distancing protocols we will need to divide students by last name and spread this over three days. It's important that students adhere to their assigned time slot so we can be safe and avoid long lines!

- Login to [www.lwsd.org](http://www.lwsd.org) and select Find It Fast from the top right corner
- Select 'Pay Fees Online' and then select 'Online Payments' and then enter login information.
- Then select your student's name, then under Reports- select Purchase History
- From here scroll and use the arrows at the top to see a full history of all purchases made. If you see the item EHS YEARBOOK 2019-20 then you have purchased a Yearbook this year.
