Return and Pickup School Materials from 19-20 School Year:

During the week of Aug 17-21 from 8:00 – 12:00 please return any school materials (i.e. textbooks, laptops etc.) that your student checked out last year. Please bring these items to the main office. You should have received a message from the LWSD about fines for outstanding items.

Laptops from last year need to be turned in to be reimaged, so they can be used this year. Laptops from last year that are not reimaged will stop working. We can give your student a loaner until their laptop is ready.

Students who were not able to pick up their belongings from last year's PE or hallway lockers can get them at their scheduled time on Aug 24-27. These items are in brown paper bags labeled with the student names.

Student Check Out:

As we head down the backstretch of August, we wanted to inform you of some important upcoming dates.

In preparation of the first day of remote instruction, we need to provide students with essential technology. On August 24-27, students will need to pick up their laptops at Eastlake. During this time, we will also hand out some textbooks/novels and take student photos.

In order to accomplish this in a safe manner that aligns with social distancing protocols we will need to divide it up by last name and spread it over four days.

It's important that your students adhere to their designated time slot so we can be safe and avoid long lines! See schedule below.

We will have make up dates to checkout laptops and textbooks for students who cannot attend during their designated time slot.

Student Schedules:

Every year, Eastlake undergoes a complex, comprehensive process to build a master schedule that serves over 2000 students. We take in an incredible amount of input and manage a lot of variables and constraints in our attempt to set both students and teachers up for success. This year has some added complexities. Even though we start remotely we need to plan for the possibility of returning to a hybrid model. However, no Eastlake classes will be cancelled this Fall.

Students should receive their schedules via email by August 27. Once school starts, students may be asked to return to school to checkout additional items.

Also, Eastlake does not have a standard list of additional school supplies. Once school starts, individual classes may require students to have specific school supplies.

Laptop Agreement Form:

This laptop agreement form is required for all 9th grade students , and for all students in grades 10-12 who are new to Eastlake this year. Please [print](#) it out and sign it, and have your student bring it to checkout so your they can check out a laptop and charger. Returning students have already done this in prior years.

Laptop Insurance:

Cracked screen fines were increased to \$300 last year so more parents have been opting to purchase insurance. Be sure to include the serial number, not the district bar code when filling out this form. [Here is the link to the laptop insurance form](#) and more information.

School Pictures:

LifeTouch photographers will once again be taking our school pictures. We use these for our Yearbook and for school ID and ASB cards. Parents can also purchase their own portrait packages from LifeTouch using this [link](#). We will not issue ID and ASB cards right away but will have more information about them at a later date. Please know that both Eastlake and LifeTouch have taken steps to ensure the safety of everyone as we start our school year.

School Fees:

At this time, we will wait on all school payments (ASB, parking pass, athletic fees, Yearbook etc.) until the Fall. We are concerned about some of our families who are experiencing economic hardship. This time will also allow us to align the fees to the level of service we can provide. We have also decided to limit course fees.

Students participating in Clubs and Athletics will need to purchase an ASB at a later time.

Link Crew for Freshmen:

We understand the importance of a warm welcome for incoming Eastlake 9th graders but given the circumstances, we remain in the planning stages for these activities.

Freshman Parent Orientation:

Video link will sent to families on Monday, August 24th followed by a time for questions on Wednesday, August 26 from 7-8 PM (Microsoft Teams live event). Video will be available via EHS website.

New Student Orientation:

Video link will be sent to families on Monday, August 24th followed by a time for questions on Wednesday, August 26 from 5:30-6:30 PM (Microsoft Teams live event). Video will be available via EHS website.

Curriculum Night:

We will also plan for a virtual Curriculum Night in September, where parents will receive more information about individual classes from teachers. More information will come out in the coming weeks

Bell Schedule:

Eastlake's bell schedule will be released by next week. This schedule will be a combination of synchronous and asynchronous instruction.

Note to students and parents regarding high school sports

As many of you know the Washington Interscholastic Activities (WIAA), the governing body for all high school sports, has announced that all Fall sports have been postponed until later in the 2020-2021 school year. The tentative schedule may be adjusted later in the fall as deemed necessary to insure the safety of our students.

The following tentative start dates were announced earlier this month, but are subject to change:

As these are unique season dates please know that:

- Seasons will be shortened to accommodate all sports
- The number of competitions will be limited to 70% of those allowed by WIAA on typical years.
- WIAA Post seasons will be one week in length.
- Student/athletes will practice and compete during our scheduled school breaks.
- Season 4 will continue after graduation AND after the academic school year.

Please still register for sports for this school year through FinalForms, no payment will be made for any sport until it is verified that a season will occur.
