Dear Wolves:

As the start of school nears, we now have more clarity about remote learning schedules for students. The LWSD has decided to create a consistent high school bell schedule for synchronous learning and the Eastlake Leadership Team has decided on the placement of the additional teacher prep and personalization time (i.e. Wolf Time and Pack Time).

With this schedule, Eastlake tried to find a balance between academic progress and student wellness.

We will now need to create alternative bell schedule for atypical weeks. We have done that for the first week of school.

Explanation

- During synchronous instruction (class periods) the teacher is delivering real time instruction via Microsoft Teams. Each class will have a range of 60-120 minutes two times per week. This range will be determined by the teacher and may vary. Synchronous learning will occur between 9 AM and 2 PM.
- During student asynchronous learning time, students will complete pre-developed or recorded lessons when convenient. Students have flexibility on their asynchronous learning time as long as they complete the work prior to next class.
- Students will have a minimum of 225 minutes of instructional activities per class each week (synchronous + asynchronous). That's equivalent 45 minutes per class per day, 5 hours and 15 minutes of learning per day and 26.25 hours of

- learning per week for 7 classes
- Teachers will be available to provide additional support for students during Personalization Time (Wolf Time.) We will provide additional clarity for Personalization Time next week.
- During Asynchronous Learning & Support teachers can be available to provide additional support for students. However, this needs to be prearranged.

We appreciate your patience and want to reiterate the importance of the partnership between school and families, especially during this time of remote schooling.

Covid Safety Plan

LWSD has developed a Covid Safety Plan to help ensure student and staff safety as we start the school year, and to ensure we are in compliance with state, county, and District policies. This plan is fully in place at Eastlake. This includes the requirement for all students, staff, parents, volunteers, and guests to wear a mask while in our schools. Please also maintain social distancing, even while wearing your mask. We will have disposable masks for anyone who forgets.

Temperature check and Covid symptom screening

Our safety plan includes checking everyone's temperature. In order to enter the school a temperature cannot be over 100.4 F. We will also make sure nobody has any of the common Covid symptoms. We have a screening table in our main lobby.

Pickup School Materials Left From the 2019-20 School Year:

Students who were not able to pick up their belongings from last year's PE or hallway lockers can get them at their scheduled time on Aug 24-27. These items are in brown paper bags labeled with the student names. If you paid for a yearbook, but have not yet picked it up, those are also available. We will not be selling any yearbooks at this time.

Student Materials Check Out:

In preparation for the first day of remote instruction, we need to provide students with essential technology and materials. Students will need to pick up their laptops and core class (Math, Science, and Humanities) textbooks at Eastlake during their designated time slot listed below. We will also take student photos during this time. Students will receive their core course (Math, Science, and Humanities) selections by email so they know what textbooks to check out.

Students should bring a backpack or sturdy bag in which to carry the items.

Due to main parking lot construction, please use the back entrance and park in the lot by the tennis courts. Students will enter by the bus loading zone. In order to minimize the number of people in the building, we ask that parents stay with their car. If a student needs special assistance, please let a staff member know. We will have additional personnel stationed outside the building.

In order to accomplish materials pick-up in a safe manner that aligns with social distancing protocols, we will need to divide students up by last name and spread the pick-up over four days.

It's important that your student adheres to their designated time slot so we can safely distribute materials and avoid long lines! See schedule below.

Make-Up Days

For students who cannot attend during their designated time slot, they can get their laptop and core textbooks on Friday, August 28 or Monday, August 31, anytime from 8am to 2pm. Additional make-up days will be before and after class time, Tuesday-Friday September 1-4, 8am - 9:30am and 2:30pm – 4pm. Make-up day for pictures will be Wednesday, Sept. 16th.

REMINDERS:

- Students and anyone entering the building must wear a mask.
- We will NOT be collecting any fines or fees during roll out week.

Student Schedules:

Every year, Eastlake undergoes a complex, comprehensive process to build a master schedule that serves over 2000 students. We take in an incredible amount of input and manage a lot of variables and constraints in our attempt to set both students and teachers up for success. This year has some added complexities. Even though we start remotely we need to plan for the possibility of returning to a hybrid model. However, no Eastlake classes will be cancelled this Fall.

Students should receive their schedules via email by August 27. Once school starts, students may be asked to return to school to checkout additional items.

Also, Eastlake does not have a standard list of additional school supplies. Once school starts, individual classes may require students to have specific school supplies.

Laptop Agreement Form:

This laptop agreement form is required for all 9th grade students , and for all students in grades 10-12 who are new to Eastlake this year. Please [print](#) it out and sign it, and have your student bring it to checkout so your they can check out a laptop and charger. Returning students have already done this in prior years.

Laptop Insurance:

Cracked screen fines were increased to \$300 last year so more parents have been opting to purchase insurance. Be sure to include the serial number, not the district bar code when filling out this form. [Here is the link to the laptop insurance form](#) and more information.

School Pictures:

LifeTouch photographers will once again be taking our school pictures. We use these for our Yearbook and for school ID and ASB cards. Parents can also purchase their own portrait packages from LifeTouch using this [link](#). Students need to be easily identifiable, school appropriate, with no hats or sunglasses. We will not issue ID and ASB cards right away but will have more information about them at a later date. Please know that both Eastlake and LifeTouch have taken steps to ensure the safety of everyone as we start our school year.

School Fees:

At this time, we will wait on all school payments: ASB, parking pass, athletic fees, Yearbook etc. We are concerned about some of our families who are experiencing economic hardship. This time will also allow us to align the fees to the level of service we can provide. We have also decided to limit course fees.

Students participating in Clubs and Athletics will need to purchase an ASB at a later time.

Link Crew for Freshmen:

Grade 9 students and families will receive a separate email about our Grade 9 welcome and upcoming Link Crew activities.
