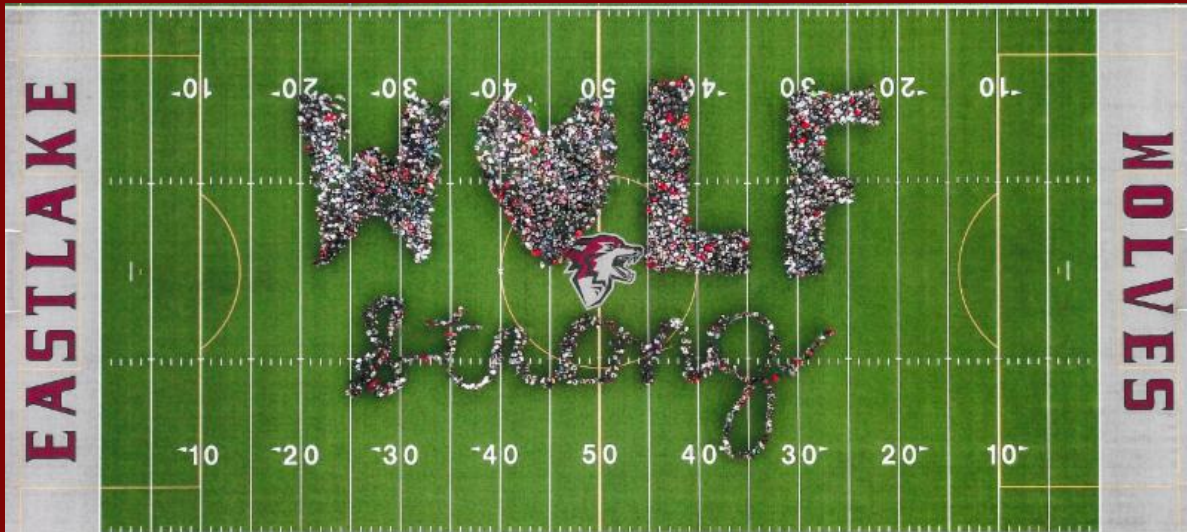

Dear Wolves,

Last year Eastlake implemented two 45-minute Wolf Times on Friday. This change provided all students the time and support to meet our high expectations.

This flexible time during the day helps Eastlake meet the various needs of all our students. Wolf Time allows students to access extra support from their teachers during the school day, as well as make up missed labs, assignments or tests. Students can sign up for collaborative spaces where they can form study groups or work on group projects. Wolf Time can also mitigate stress and help students balance their busy lives by providing academic work time during the school day.

Wolf Time will continue providing a lot of enrichment opportunities for students. In the past, the World Language Department brought in refugees from Venezuela to speak about their experience. We accessed the student interest inventory in Xello to invite individual students to a presentation on aerospace science from Boeing engineers. Counselors put on multiple workshops to help students with career and college planning. Colleges often visit Eastlake during this time. AP teachers used Wolf Time for final preparations before the test. We even offered yoga for students who preferred a calming experience in the middle of the day. We will continue to expand these enrichment opportunities for students during Wolf Time.

Wolf Time is also instructional time where all students are required to be in their assigned location. If a student misses one Wolf Time they will be marked absent in their 4th period class. Skipping Wolf Time may also result in school service.

For Wolf Time, we use a sign-up program called FlexiSched. Using this website, students or teachers can make requests, and the school can track attendance. This week students started making choices of where to be during Wolf Time.

Throughout the year, we will keep you posted on upcoming Wolf Time activities. Parents can also help by talking with your student about where they plan to spend their time, or simply just reminding them to sign up for Wolf Time sessions on

Wednesday during Period 4.

Make Up Photo Day:

Photo Make Up Day is Wednesday September 11th at 12:25 PM and is for all students that have not had their school picture taken yet. For those of you who ride a bus please be aware that you may have to make other transportation arrangements on this day.

Off Campus Lunch Pass:

If your student is in 10th, 11th or 12th grade parents can complete the online permission form for an [Off Campus Pass](#). Please do this before the Make Up Photo Day on Wednesday September 11th.

Parking Permit:

If your student is in 11th or 12th grade complete the [Parking Permit Application](#) Form and [pay](#) for the Parking Permit. Students must bring in their Driver's License to pick up their Parking Permits from the Bookkeeping Window. Tickets will be issued to any vehicle without an EHS 2019-20 Parking Permit.

PSAT:

Juniors do not miss your chance to take the PSAT/National Merit Scholarship test. This test prepares Juniors for their official SAT test and enters them into the National Merit Scholarship program which provides college scholarships and national recognition. All Juniors thinking about applying to college next year should take this optional test. It is held Wed. Oct. 16 as part of the standard EHS day. The cost is \$17 for Juniors, and payment must be made by Oct. 9th. No refunds allowed. If you need financial assistance please contact your Counselor. (Please note all Sophomores are required to take a version of this test on Oct. 16 which is paid for by LWSD. Sophomore results are for practice purposes only as they cannot qualify for National Merit. If your student took this test as a Sophomore, they should take it again as a Junior.)

Yearbooks:

The first sales period ends 9/13/19. Selling begins again in December, and we always sell out. Yearbooks are \$65 and can be paid online [here](#) or students can bring cash or check (Payable to EHS) to the Bookkeeping Window before school and during lunches.

Class Fees:

All class fees will be automatically loaded to student accounts on 9/11/19. You can go online and pay class fees [here](#) beginning 9/11/19. Scholarships

Washington State University (WSU) Regents Scholars Nomination

Eastlake will nominate two seniors for the [WSU Regents Scholars Program](#). All eligible nominees receive a four-year Regents Program scholarship (\$4,000 per academic year for four years) with the opportunity to compete for a Distinguished Regents Scholar Award (Full tuition and mandatory fees for up to 18 credits per semester, for four years). Interested students must complete the [Eastlake Scholarship Nomination Form](#) by Friday, September 27, 2019 to be considered for the nomination.

Other Nomination Scholarships

We are occasionally asked to nominate one or two senior or junior students for scholarship opportunities. Eligibility criteria varies widely. Students who would like to be considered for nomination opportunities should submit the [Eastlake Scholarship Nomination Form](#). Eastlake evaluates submissions against the nomination scholarship criteria and asks the best qualified student(s) to move forward with the nomination process. **Please remember that most scholarships do not require a nomination.** Stay informed and check the scholarship tab on the College and Career
