Dear Wolves:

As we start the third week, we want to remind everyone of the parameters for remote learning. Students are expected to engage with this learning. They will have approximately 3-5 hours of assigned learning each day. This will include approximately 30-45 min per class per day or 15-25 hours/week. By Monday, teachers will post assignments and communicate with families about the new learning expectations for the week. This could be a schedule for the week with daily activities or a longer project to be completed over multiple days.

Most of the learning will occur unsynchronized, meaning students will have the flexibility to complete it on their own schedule during the week. However, we created a schedule for Office Hours to allow for some synchronized learning experiences for students without creating conflicts. These live learning experiences could include student check-ins, question and answer sessions, discussions, reinforcement of concepts etc. These times are not required for either teachers to organize or students to attend. However, we strongly recommend that students attend if their teachers set them up.

At this time, teachers are not using videoconferencing in Teams to deliver primary instruction and/or to introduce new concepts. It is expected that teachers will post essential instruction for anytime access through a recorded or static format available to all students. Pre-recorded video lessons and voice-over PowerPoints are such options to deliver primary instruction and/or introduce new concepts for teachers who choose to do so. These options provide the greatest flexibility for students, families and teachers.

For this remote learning Eastlake continues to follow the guidance of OSPI (Office of the Superintendent of Public Instruction) and the LWSD.

At the start of next week, we will be sending out a student survey via email and social media to collect feedback on the successes and challenges of remote learning.
